**WEATHER OUTLOOK OVER NORTH WEST INDIA INCLUDING DELHI
NCR DURING NEXT ONE WEEK**

A western disturbance as an upper air trough lies along long. 68 deg. E to the north of Lat. 25 deg. N which is going to be interact with a low pressure system now seen as a deep depression over northeast Arabian Sea which is also likely to cross south Gujarat coast. Under the influence of the interaction of the above two systems fairly widespread to widespread rain/thundershowers would occur over Jammu and Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan during 23rd to 27th June-2015. The rainfall activity will decrease thereafter over this region.

Isolated to scattered heavy to very heavy rainfall may occur over Jammu and Kashmir during 23rd to 25th June, over Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand during 24th to 26th June with occasional extreme heavy fall. Isolated heavy rainfall may occur over Punjab, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan during 24th to 26th June-2015.

Rain/thundershowers would occur over many parts of Delhi and NCR during 23rd to 26th June. Occasionally heavy rainfall could also occur over Delhi during the same period.
